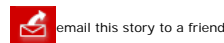
The program will run from January 7-19 in 2008.

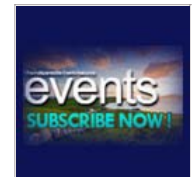

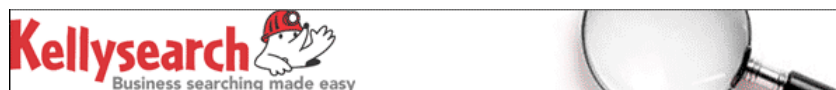
